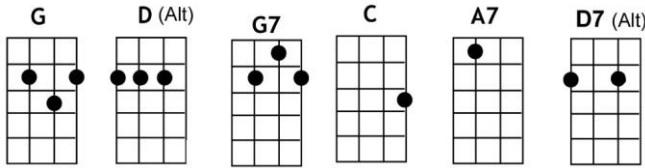


All I Do is Dream of You ~ written by Nacio Herb Brown and Arthur Freed
