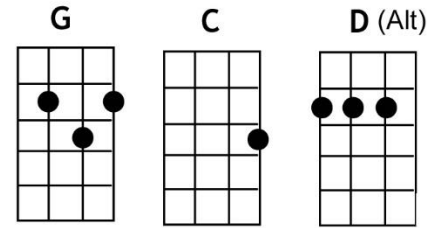


BLOWIN' IN THE WIND by Bob Dylan
