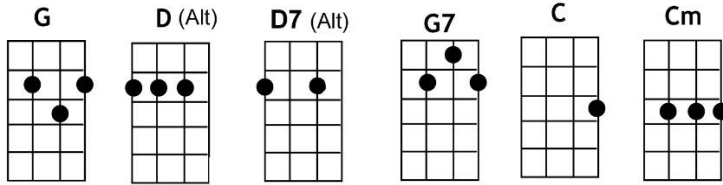


Don't Fence Me In ~ written by Cole Porter, lyrics by Robert Fletcher
