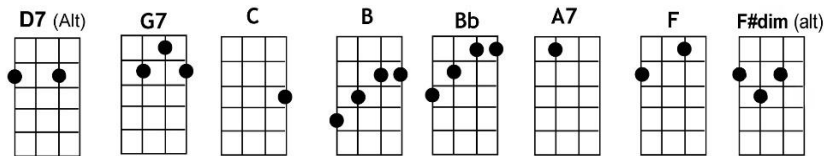
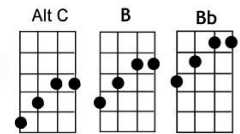


# Lazy River ~ written by Hoagy Carmichael and Sidney Arodin
