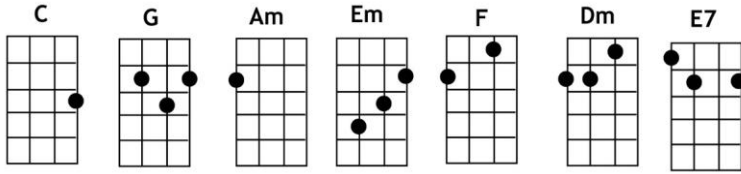


Let It Be Me
