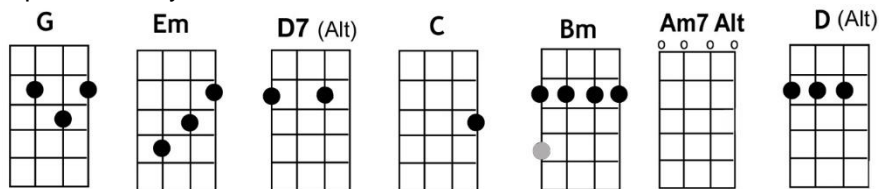


Listen To The Rhythm Of The Falling Rain
