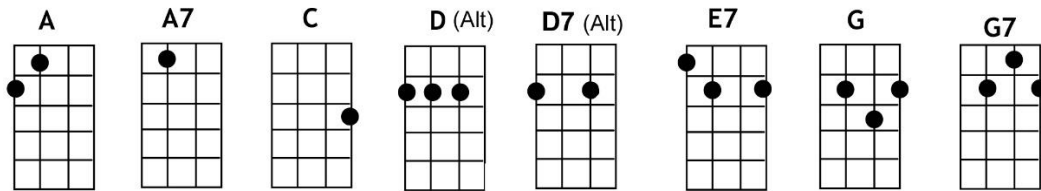


Me and Bobby McGee ~ written by Kris Kristofferson; ~ as performed by Janis Joplin, etc.
