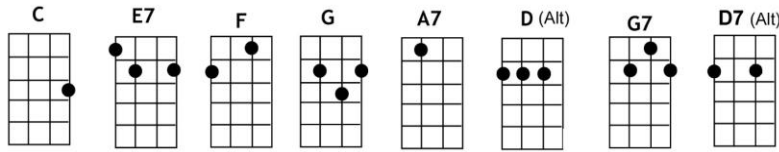


# (Now and Then, There's) A Fool Such As I
