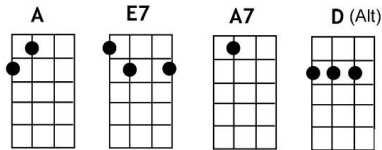


Rollin' In My Sweet Baby's Arms ~ Traditional
