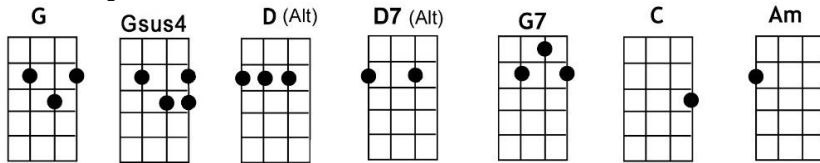


Sloop John B ~ Traditional, arranged by Brian Wilson; performed by The Beach Boys **(chord) = one strum**

INTRO/Count in: **Shelley** (or Chantal) **[G] [Gsus4] x 4** or 1-2-3-4 - We come on...

We **[G]** come on the Sloop **[Gsus4]** John **[G]** B, my grandfather **[Gsus4]** and **[G]** me
[G] 'Round Nas-**[Gsus4]**-sau **[G]** town, we did **[D]** roam **[D7]**
[D7] Drinkin' all **[G]** night - **[G7]** got into a **[C]** fight **[Am]**
[Am] Well, I **[G]** feel so broke up - **[D7]** I wanna go **[G]** home **[Gsus4]** **[G]**

So **[G]** hoist up the John **[Gsus4]** B **[G]** sails,
[G] See how the main-**[Gsus4]**-sail **[G]** sets
[G] Call for the Captain **[Gsus4]** a-**[G]**-shore, let me go **[D]** home **[D7]**
[D7] Let me go **[G]** home - **[G7]** I wanna go **[C]** home, yeah, **[Am]** yeah
[Am] Well, I **[G]** feel so broke up - **[D7]** I wanna go **[G]** home **[Gsus4]** **[G]**

The **[G]** first mate he **[Gsus4]** got **[G]** drunk - **[G]** broke in the Cap-**[Gsus4]**-tain's **[G]** trunk
The **[G]** constable had **[Gsus4]** to **[G]** come and take him a-**[D]**-way **[D7]**
[D7] Sheriff John **[G]** Stone, **[G7]** why don't you leave me a-**[C]**-lone? **[Am]**
Well, I **[G]** feel so broke up - **[D7]** I wanna go **[G]** home **[Gsus4]** **[G]**

So **[G]** hoist up the John **[Gsus4]** B **[G]** sails (*hoist up the John B sails*)
[G] See how the main-**[Gsus4]**-sail **[G]** sets (*see how the main-sail sets*)
[G] Call for the Captain **[Gsus4]** a-**[G]**-shore, let me go **[D]** home **[D7]** (*let me go home*)
[D7] Let me go **[G]** home - **[G7]** I wanna go **[C]** home, yeah, **[Am]** yeah (*hoist up the JBS*)
[Am] Well, I **[G]** feel so broke up - **[D7]** I wanna go **[G]** home **[Gsus4]** **[G]** (*do-do-do-do...*)

The **[G]** poor cook he caught **[Gsus4]** the **[G]** fits, threw away all **[Gsus4]** my **[G]** grits
[G] Then he took **[Gsus4]** and **[G]** ate up all of my **[D]** corn **[D7]**
[D7] Let me go **[G]** home, **[G7]** why don't they let me go **[C]** home? **[Am]**
This **[G]** is the worst trip **[D7]** I've ever been **[G]** on **[Gsus4]** **[G]**

ACAPELLA – No Strumming:

So **[G]** hoist up the John **[Gsus4]** B **[G]** sails (*hoist up the John B sails*)
[G] See how the main-**[Gsus4]**-sail **[G]** sets (*see how the main-sail sets*)
[G] Call for the Captain **[Gsus4]** a-**[G]**-shore, let me go **[D]** home **[D7]** (*let me go home*)
Start Strumming / Singing Again:
[D7] Let me go **[G]** home - **[G7]** I wanna go **[C]** home, yeah, **[Am]** yeah (*hoist up the JBS*)
[Am] Well, I **[G]** feel so broke up - **[D7]** I wanna go **[G]** home **[Gsus4]** **[G]** (*do-do-do-do...*)

CHORUS: So **[G]** hoist up the John **[Gsus4]** B **[G]** sails,
[G] See how the main-**[Gsus4]**-sail **[G]** sets
[G] Call for the Captain **[Gsus4]** a-**[G]**-shore, let me go **[D]** home **[D7]**
[D7] Let me go **[G]** home - **[G7]** I wanna go **[C]** home, yeah, **[Am]** yeah
