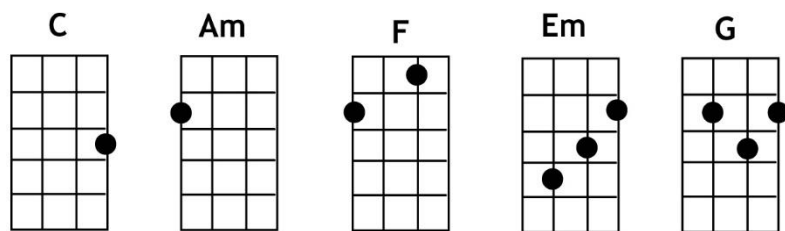


They Call The Wind Mariah ~ written by Lerner & Loewe (from Paint Your Wagon);

Vocal starts on C

INTRO/Count in: **Cathy** [C] [Am] [C] [Am] *Way out here...*

[C] Way out here they've [Am] got a name for [C] wind and rain and [Am] fire
The [F] rain is Tess, the [Em] fire's Joe, and they [F] call the [G] wind Ma-[C]-riah [C]

Ma-[C]-riah blows the [Am] stars around and [C] sends the clouds a'- [Am] flyin'
Ma-[F]-riah makes the [Em] mountains sound like [F] folks up [G] there were [C] dyin' [C]

Ma-[Am]-riah, [Am] Ma-[C]-riah, [C] They [F] call the [G] wind Ma-[C]-riah [C]

Be-[C]-fore I knew Ma-[Am]-riah's name, and [C] heard her wail and [Am] whinin'
I [F] had a gal and [Em] she had me, and the [F] sun was [G] always [C] shinin' [C]

But [C] then one day I [Am] left that gal, I [C] left her far be-[Am]-hind me
And [F] now I'm lost, so [Em] gone and lost, not [F] even [G] God can [C] find me [C]

Ma-[Am]-riah, [Am] Ma-[C]-riah, [C] They [F] call the [G] wind Ma-[C]-riah [C]

Out [C] here they've got a [Am] name for rain, for [C] wind and fire [Am] only
But [F] when you're lost and [Em] all alone, there [F] ain't no [G] word but [C] lonely [C]

I feel [C] just like the [Am] restless wind, with-[C]-out a star to [Am] guide me
Ma-[F]-riah blow my [Em] love to me, I [F] need my [G] love be-[C]-side me [C]

Ma-[Am]-riah, [Am] Ma-[C]-riah, [C] They [F] call the [G] wind Ma-[C]-riah [C]

Ma-[Am]-riah, [Am] Ma-[Em]-riah, **(Em) ... slower:** (F) Blow my (G) love to (C) me
