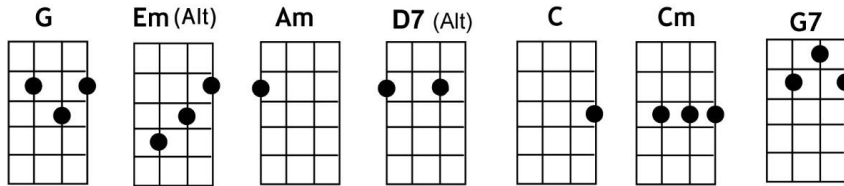

SUGGESTED STRUM:
Slow. . . one strum per beat

INTRO: Bob...while everyone strums over chords in first 2 lines of CHORUS
