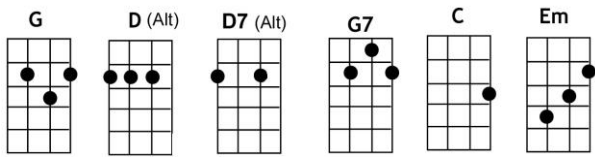


## Under The Boardwalk
