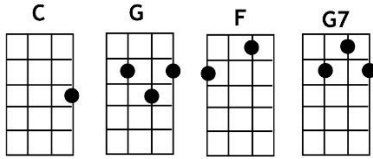


Up Around The Bend ~ written by John Fogarty; performed by Creedence Clearwater Revival

INTRO: **Paul** Lead riff or strum in [C] [C] [G] [C]

CHORUS: [F] Come on, the [C] risin' [G7] wind

[C] Bring a song and a smile for the banjo
[G] Better get, while the [G7] gettin's [C] good
